

SITUATION: (A1) Due to recent flooding, 30 head of beef cattle are stranded on a levee. The cattle will require feed until the water recedes in approximately 5 days.

NEEDS:

- Watercraft to transport hay
- Approximately 600 pounds of hay

SITUATION: (A2) Due to recent flooding, 30 feeder calves (400-600 lbs. each) were swept away and drowned. Local responders are requesting assistance to move the carcasses from the public riverbank to higher ground until they can be transported to the landfill.

NEEDS:

- Equipment to move carcasses from the riverbank
- Equipment operators

SITUATION: (A3) Approximately 50 feeder calves (400-600 lbs. each) were removed from the river after recent flooding. Local responders are now requesting assistance to transport of the carcasses to the landfill.

NEEDS:

- Transportation to disposal site
- Personnel with a CDL license

SITUATION: (A4) Downed fences from recent storms have caused approximately 40 head of beef cattle to wander onto the interstate creating a hazard for motorists.

NEEDS:

- Containment system
- Grain for luring cattle
- Transportation for cattle

SITUATION: (A5) Severe storms destroyed the local emergency shelter housing displaced people, therefore a cattle show facility must be repurposed as a human shelter. To keep roads clear for emergency vehicles, 20 beef cattle need to be contained on-site for 72-hours until the owners can retrieve them.

NEEDS:

- Cattle feed to sustain cattle during the containment period
- Potable water for cattle
- Security personnel to oversee cattle

SITUATION: (A6) A semi-tractor trailer overturned on the interstate trapping 10 cattle. 40 additional head of cattle are loose on the road. First responders are requesting euthanasia for downed livestock and aid in capturing loose cattle.

NEEDS:

- Authorized personnel for euthanasia
- 10 personnel to capture livestock

SITUATION: (A7) Straight-line winds caused a portion of the public fairground barn to collapse and kill 50 head of cattle. Fairground management requests assistance with carcass removal.

NEEDS:

- Equipment for carcass removal
- Transportation of carcasses to disposal site

SITUATION: (A8) Local beef farmers report catastrophic damages to fences after a tornado. News reports indicate a need for fencing supplies and erroneously direct donations to the county fire stations. Unsolicited donated supplies are blocking fire apparatuses.

NEEDS:

- Donations management site
- 6 staff to manage distribution center

SITUATION: (A9) 100 head of beef cattle are stranded in 2-3 feet of floodwaters and need to be relocated to higher grounds.

NEEDS:

- 10 personnel trained in water rescue
- Watercraft to herd the cattle to higher ground

SITUATION: (A10) A semi-tractor trailer overturned on the interstate. 40 head of beef cattle are loose. Responders need assistance with transportation and relocation of the cattle.

NEEDS:

- Transportation for moving cattle
- Holding location suitable for relocated cattle

SITUATION: (A11) A natural disaster has left area farmers struggling to provide adequate feed for cattle. Elementary school students posted a need for animal feed on social media. Now, feed donations are pouring in at the local public schools.

NEEDS:

- Inventory system
- Method for notifying the public of donation sites and feed types available

SITUATION: (A12) A natural disaster has damaged 2,000 feet of livestock fencing. Crews need to repair it quickly to contain cattle.

NEEDS:

- Fencing repair crew
- Fencing supplies

SITUATION: (A13) A fairgrounds livestock barn is designated for human sheltering. Therefore, the facility needs to be cleaned and disinfected.

NEEDS:

- 6 personnel with just-in-time training
- Cleaning and disinfecting supplies

SITUATION: (A14) Miles of livestock fencing are flattened due to high winds. 75 stray cattle must be collected and transported to a holding location and identified until owners can legally reclaim them.

NEEDS:

- 10 personnel with livestock experience to help with cattle identification
- Truck(s) and trailer(s) to transport cattle to holding site

SITUATION: (A15) During a controlled burn, fire accidentally spread rapidly and now cause 30 cattle to bolt through a fence onto a public roadway.

NEEDS:

- 5+ personnel with cattle handling experience
- Containment out of harm's way

SITUATION: (A16) 5 steers were brought to a college campus for an educational seminar. Someone forgot to close the gate and the steers are now roaming the city streets. First responders require assistance in catching them before bystanders are injured.

NEEDS:

- 10 personnel with cattle-handling experience
- Shovels and buckets for manure management on the public streets

SITUATION: (A17) Recent rain caused significant mudslides trapping 12 show cattle at the county fairgrounds. Fair workers require assistance creating an egress point for the cattle.

NEEDS:

- Equipment for mud removal from roads and barn area
- Personnel for mud removal from roads and barn area

SITUATION: (A18) A bull escaped from the local stockyard then fell into a sinkhole in the public park and broke his femur. Families attending a wedding nearby are gathering to the scene and the bull needs to be euthanized (permission is granted by owner).

NEEDS:

- 1 person authorized for humane euthanasia
- 3 people for crowd control
- A wedding gift for the happy couple

SITUATION: (A19) A bull escaped from the local stockyard then fell into a sinkhole in the public park and died. The sinkhole connects to an aquifer used for the public drinking water supply. The carcass needs to be removed.

NEEDS:

- Equipment to remove bull from the sinkhole
- Personnel to operate equipment to remove bull from the sinkhole

SITUATION: (A20) Lightning strikes at a county fairgrounds, setting the building on fire and killing 10 head of cattle. Due to local regulations, the carcasses must be composted offsite.

NEEDS:

- Personnel with composting knowledge
- Vehicle appropriate for moving carcasses offsite
