

SITUATION: (C1) An equine emergency shelter has been established.

NEEDS:

- Water for cleaning
- Cleaning supplies (buckets, mops, disinfectant, paper towels, gloves, garbage bags etc.)

SITUATION: (C2) Scheduled equine shelter volunteers are unable to work due to illness. The shelter is short-staffed.

NEEDS:

- Six volunteers with just-in-time training
- Shelter coordinator

SITUATION: (C3) A train derailed and causes an explosion, requiring a nearby horse boarding facility to shelter-in-place for 4 days. Donated horse feed needs to be transported to the facility.

NEEDS:

- Transportation for donated materials
- Licensed driver

SITUATION: (C4) A donations management site needs to be established for incoming equine feed, hay, and supplies.

NEEDS:

- Site protected from the weather with adequate space to process and store donations
- 4 people to sort donations

SITUATION: (C5): Truckloads of equine donations from across the region are arriving in Calamity County. The donations include feed, hay and supplies.

NEEDS:

- 5 people to sort donations
- 1 adult to serve as donations processing manager
