

SITUATION: (A1) Animals accompanying their owners are being brought to a human shelter, that isn't equipped for animal sheltering and need to be transported and sheltered at the new animal facility.

NEEDS:

- Vehicle(s)
- Means of containment to transport 30 small and medium-sized pets 20 miles within a 2-hour time limit

SITUATION: (A2) Rescued animals need to be transported to the emergency animal shelter.

NEEDS:

- 4 responsible licensed drivers over the age of 18 to transport animals
- Supplies to record locations where animals were rescued

SITUATION: (A3) Shelter staff observe several pets brought in are sick or injured.

NEEDS:

- 2 animal health specialists (veterinary technicians or licensed veterinarians)
- Personal protective equipment

SITUATION: (A4) Shelter staff report many pets were brought in wet, shivering, and smelling of sewage. 20 animals need to be bathed, brushed, and dried.

NEEDS:

- Grooming supplies (shampoo, brushes, towels, dryers, etc.)
- Clean water for baths

SITUATION: (A5) Shelter staff report many pets were brought in wet, shivering, and smelling of sewage. 20 pets must be bathed, brushed, and dried within the next 4 hours.

- 4 adult workers to clean the pets
- Clean bedding and towels

SITUATION: (A6) Animal shelter staff report many pets were brought in wet, shivering, and smelling of sewage. 20 pets must be bathed, brushed, and dried within the next 4 hours. Personnel must wear personal protective equipment (PPE) to protect their skin and eyes.

NEEDS:

- 4 Decontamination personnel
- PPE for 4 adults (aprons/coveralls, eye protection, long-sleeved gloves etc.)

SITUATION: (A7) An emergency response shelter must be established to care for 75 pets affected by this disaster.

NEEDS:

- 2 veterinary technicians
- 1 animal shelter manager
- 6 adults trained for daily care (may receive just-in-time training)

SITUATION: (A8) An emergency shelter has been established to care for 75 pets affected by this disaster, but the shelter has no food or pet waste disposal capability.

NEEDS:

- Pet food for 75 pets for 3 days
- Supplies for pet waste collection and disposal

SITUATION: (A9) An emergency shelter has been established to care for 75 pets affected by this disaster. Cleaning supplies and personnel are needed to maintain the new shelter site.

NEEDS:

- Cleaning supplies (buckets, mops, disinfectant, paper towels, gloves, garbage bags etc.)
- 6 personnel with a minimum of 1 adult

SITUATION: (A10): An emergency shelter must be established to care for 75 pets in crates affected by this disaster.

NEEDS:

- Facility with electricity and running water suitable for animal shelter
- Social media expert to communicate details regarding new shelter site

SITUATION: (A11): An emergency shelter must be established to care for 75 pets affected by this disaster.

NEEDS:

- 1 veterinarian technician or veterinarian
- Shelter equipment for 40 cats and 35 dogs (crates, bowls, leashes, litter and litter pans etc.)

SITUATION: (A12) The majority of animals being dropped off at the shelter have no identification.

NEEDS:

- 3 personnel
- Supplies to create a system for intake, identification, and reunification

SITUATION: (A13) Calamity County has done a terrific job providing information through its social media accounts. However, many residents lack access. An emergency hotline is being established to address the concerns of community pet owners.

NEEDS:

- 1 subject matter expert with animal-related knowledge to develop pre-scripted messages
- 6 adults to answer the hotline
- Shared database (paper or electronic) for logging calls and tracking information

SITUATION: (A14) Community-wide social media discussions about the disaster create the need to communicate approved messages and track public feedback and posts on the shelter's social media account.

NEEDS:

- 1 individual with social media experience
- Office space with electricity
- Technology to access social media accounts

SITUATION: (A15) One semi-tractor trailer load and five pickup truck loads of mixed donations including pet food, supplies, and equipment have arrived in Calamity County.

NEEDS:

- Reception site protected from the weather with adequate space to process and store donations
- Supplies to sort and distribute donations

SITUATION: (A16) One semi-tractor trailer load and five pickup truck loads of mixed donations including pet food, supplies, and equipment have arrived in Calamity County.

NEEDS:

- 10 personnel to process donations and 1 adult to serve as donations processing manager
- Supplies or equipment for tracking inventory

SITUATION: (A17) Calls are received about dogs and cats stranded on the tops of roofs, cars, and porches surrounded by water.

NEEDS:

- 2 adult animal rescue personnel with documented animal handling skills
- Supplies for animal identification and tracking
- Animal rescue equipment (catch poles, leashes, carriers, etc.)

SITUATION: (A18) Calls are received about dogs and cats stranded on the tops of roofs, cars, and porches surrounded by water.

NEEDS:

- Vehicle and driver to transport animals to shelter
- 1 animal health professional for triage

SITUATION: (A19) Some individuals are sheltering-in-place and need animal food and supplies. There are a total of 12 stranded residents plus their pets (average of 3 pets each).

NEEDS:

- Food and supplies to care for their animals in their home (pet food, human food, potable water, litter etc.)

SITUATION: (A20) Some individuals choose to shelter-in-place and are in need of animal food and supplies. There are a total of 12 stranded residents plus their pets (average of 3 pets each).

NEEDS:

- 2-person delivery team, one of which with current driver's license and vehicle
- Cleaning supplies

SITUATION: (A21) Due to widespread illness, the public health department is mandating social distancing protocols at the local emergency shelter.

NEEDS:

- Additional shelter facility to house 20 evacuees and their pets
- Minimum 5 adults to serve as shelter staff

SITUATION: (A22) Due to widespread illness, the public health department is mandating increased biosecurity protocols at the local emergency shelter.

NEEDS:

- Personal protective equipment (gloves, masks, etc.)
- Cleaning and sanitizing supplies
- Individual with just-in-time training to assist with health screenings

SITUATION: (A23) The emergency operations center is operating virtually. One employee is without power and cannot access the online emergency management portal to perform their essential functions.

NEEDS:

- Generator
- Vehicle and driver to deliver and set up the generator

SITUATION: (A24) In an attempt to prevent the spread of disease, some evacuees with pets are sheltering in hotels. Animal health needs are being triaged on-site.

NEEDS:

- 1 individual with veterinarian training
- 2 individuals with animal care experience
- 1 vehicle

SITUATION: (A25) The safety officer establishes infectious disease safety protocols for response personnel.

NEEDS:

- 2 personnel to develop and implement a contact tracing system
- Supplies and/or equipment for documentation
